The ANF will soon commence preliminary discussions on your behalf with most aged care employers for a new Enterprise Bargaining Agreement. Most Agreements (which we hope will run from 2008 to 2012) will involve both the ANF and HSU as at present.

The basis of the ANF position is the general Log of Claims which was endorsed by an aged care members meeting on June 12 (Ibis Hotel, 15 Therry St, Melbourne at 2.30pm) and which is on the website. *However, it is also very helpful in discussions to have your views about what you feel ought to be the particular focus of discussions with your employer – and ultimately included in your Agreement.*

How good your Agreement is will depend on how active and enthusiastic ANF members across the facilities owned by your employer are! To help ANF achieve an EBA that meets the needs of ANF members we need *you* to tell us about the most important issues in your workplace!
