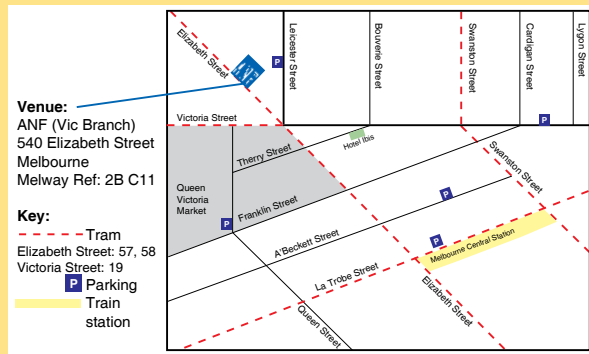


## ANF Conference Centre

### Refunds and cancellations
