- Support the National organisation of Division 2 Nurses known as NENA— National Enrolled Nurse Association.

Local Networking

A statewide network of committed Division 2 Registered Nurses and Nursing students has been established. National Network

Enrolled Nurse Groups in various forms have developed across the country. At the inaugural National Enrolled Nurse Conference held in August 1995 in Hobart, delegates voted overwhelmingly in favour of a resolution to form a National Group for Enrolled Nurses. The formation of such a Group is seen as a significant step in uniting Enrolled Nurses both within their own States and Territories through the Federal arena. Following the 1996 National Enrolled Nurse Conference in Adelaide, NENA was officially established as a national entity. NENA covers all Australian States and Territories with elected representatives from all States and Territories.
