The ANF Library is a member-only service providing a unique collection that reflects past, current and future issues in nursing and labour law. The library regularly acquires new publications and the collection is constantly under review.

The collection includes material on: evidence based practice, infection control, primary health care, health promotion, rural nursing, palliative care, midwifery, maternal and child health, aged care, complementary therapies, documentation, nursing history, ethics, disputes and campaigns, nursing and the law, career path and structure, Federal ANF policies, ANF (Victorian Branch) policies, politics and health, back injuries, occupational health and safety, bullying, workplace violence and aggression and transcultural issues.

The librarian is available to assist members with individual research projects and assignments through searches using nursing literature databases and the internet. A photocopier is also available (10 cents per copy).

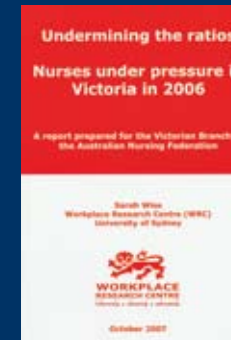
